My name is Christy and I have been reading your website and it makes a lot of sense to me. I'm sort of stuck right now between Evangelical Christianity and Messianic Judaism. I became a born-again believer when I was 9 in Sunday school. I've been in the Nazarene church, Methodist, Baptist basically been evangelical my whole life. I've got ministers and missionaries in my family too. I even went to Tyndale Bible college.

Just recently I've understood that being Torah observant is very important to our Lord. I was studying the history of Christmas and Easter and the Sungod Sunday I was completely shocked to know the evil origins of it all.
