Thank you so much, brother. This is an excellent comment and more people need to hear the truth. I was saved only quite recently (last year), all praise to the LORD! I had only a very brief knowledge of the Bible (mostly the Torah) before that and so, once born-again, I felt a deep urge to study the Word, beginning with the OT. From there it is clear as a day that we should remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy- not the "Lord's day" on Sunday. It is obvious that we should observe the Feasts...and be more close to the biblical view on time and seasons. I find it baffling how Christians around me are offended and argumentative when I gently suggest that the Sabbath is the seventh day that the LORD blessed and hallowed...and that it is a day of complete rest. And certainly, I get the strangest looks when I mention that we should keep the Passover or the Day of Atonement. And even stranger looks when I refuse to eat pork, blood (black pudding), unclean seafood or beef fat. But the Bible is clear about these things. What excuse there is for a Christian who studies the Bible, somebody who has read by himself the laws and the statutes

the LORD gave us...and yet he goes to work on Saturdays, eats leavened bread during the Feast of Matzot or starts every day with a plate of bacon and eggs? Just like we should adhere to the 10 Commandments, we should follow all the permanent (meaning: for all generations) laws of Moses.

Avram: This is the first paragraph of my comment:

I have been a pastor since 1983 and I have a question for you about our Christian lifestyle. In the 28 chapters of the Book of Acts, Luke uses the Feasts of Israel 7 times. That's an average of one Feast of Israel every 4 chapters, and 6 of those Feasts he uses as Time Markers (Acts 2:1; 12:3-4; 20:6, 16; 27:9). A Time Marker is an event that everyone is familiar with, and so you can use it instead of speaking of the actual date. For instance, if I said I'll meet you the day after Xmas, you'd know it's Dec. 26th. I wouldn't have to mention the date. Luke uses 6 Feasts of Israel like that to tell his Gentile friend Theophilus (Acts 1:1) WHEN Paul and others were at a particular place. How can Luke, a Gentile, use various Feasts of Israel as Time Markers when the Church teaches that Mosaic Law was invalidated for Christians at the death of Jesus? Luke wrote Acts, the only divinely inspired history of the Apostolic Church in 64 AD or 34 years AFTER the death and Resurrection of Jesus, and Luke never uses Roman dating. Luke is either diametrically going against the teaching of the Church, or the Church is wrong about Mosaic Law being invalidated at the Cross, for the Feasts of Israel are part of Mosaic Law (cf. Lev. 23).

Marek in Great Britain contacted me and asked me about Itzhak Shapira. I responded with an article I wrote about him (which anyone can have by asking me for, *Shapira—Enemy of the Gospel*), and Marek wrote back and said,

Dear Avram

Thankyou so much for taking the time to send this article (which i have read) and reply to my message. I am very troubled by this mans teaching...its cunning and extremely seductive. Are you basically saying in your discernment that Shaipra interprets Scripture through Kabbalistic insights?

I spoke with Shapira's British representative a few weeks ago (she contacted our "messianic" fellowship to ask if we would be interested in attending Shapira's conference this Saturday).

I see from following Shapira on FB that they seem to target African Churches, and churches from poorer regions and economic backgrounds (This messianic conference in Manchester is in a Ugandan Church.) But that all these Gentile looking men (generalisation) are wearing prayer shawls and yarmulkes...Obviously drawing persons into Levitical Torah, rather that Torah through the prism of Messiah's fulfilment of it; that being the subject matter of the sermon on the mount, the epistles, etc.

With that in mind...I told her Rabbinical Judaism was Ichabod. She went ballistic. I wasn't expecting such a strong reaction from her. Why would that be do you think? Is it because Shapira teaches that through the Zohar, etc., the Rabbis actually have a closer understanding of truth than those who hold to Scripture (and revelation through the work of the Holy Spirit - that emphasises the triunity of the Godhead...the persons of the Godhead etc etc)?
