Sunday, Feb. 12, 2023

From Justin, writing about my presentation of the Feasts in Israel in Acts, as Time Markers:

Your reasoning isn't flawed, it's perfect, if a little long winded. Paul telling us to keep the feast of Passover and unleavened bread is a short, clear, and absolute proof that the Sabbaths were not done away with. As far as not being "under the law," I think there are two ways to look at that. One, we aren't under the curse of the law. The death penalty has been lifted. Two, we don't need the sacrifices anymore. Neither one of those things mean we aren't obligated to keep God's commandments that define sin. Only those who do the will of the Father will enter the Kingdom of Heaven."

My reply:

Thanks! We're certainly "not under the Law" because the Law's penalty of death is satisfied both in Jesus taking our just punishment, which we by faith align ourselves with, and part of that alignment is that we have died to self (Rom. 6:1f.). Therefore, the Law does not have the authority to condemn us because dead folks are not affected by condemnation. The Law's authority to condemn stops at death. Yet, the Law is still God's Standard for our Christian lifestyle, as it was for Paul (cf. Acts 21:20-24) and John (cf. 1st John 2:6; Heb. 13:8).

As for not needing sacrifices anymore, this is a misreading of Hebrews where it says, "once and for all" (Heb. 7:27; 10:10). "Once" means that Jesus doesn't have to be re-sacrificed for every generation, and "for all" means that He did it for every soul ever conceived; past, present and future. As you'll see in Acts 21:20-24, the Apostle Paul, 25 years after the Resurrection, was told by James to walk into the Nazarite Vow (with its shaving of the head; Num. 6:5, 18-19), which also involved three animal sacrifices for him AND the four other men he was asked to pay for in their Nazarite Vow, which totals 15 animal sacrifices. And that was to prove that Paul still kept the Law (Acts 21:24).

All that to say that neither Paul, Peter, John or James or the thousands of Jews who kept Mosaic Law and were zealous for it (Acts 21:20), thought Mosaic sacrifice had ended with the one time sacrifice of Jesus Christ.

Wednesday, Feb. 15, 2023

From Octavius, who calls himself a prophet:

Avram Yehoshua your doctrine is all mixed up.

Avram's reply:

Shalom Octavius!

May the Peace of the Jewish Messiah Jesus be with you today and forever!

You say my doctrine is all mixed up, but you give no specific example nor tell me how to unmix it. I will give you plenty to pray about and please feel free to contact me through my website. Illicit SEX is an acronym for Sunday, Easter and Xmas, which also includes the eating of biblically unclean animals such as shrimp, pig and lobster, etc., and the Church's teaching against Mosaic Law, which came into Christianity through Pope Sixtus in 120 AD. The Pope was the one who changed Sabbath to Sunday, Passover to Easter and threw out Mosaic Law (cf. Dan. [7:25](#)) and brought in anti-Mosaic Law theology and Christian anti-Semitism. It wasn't God nor is it written in the New Testament that Mosaic Law is nullified for Christians, despite a few New Testament texts that the Church uses to justify its heretical position. (It would be Pope Julius I, around 350 AD, who brought in Xmas.) Sixtus could replace Passover with Easter, etc., because very few Christians had any portion of the NT, let alone all of it where they could check and see if Sixtus was right about God's position against the Jews and Mosaic Law (e.g. see Romans 11:25f., where Paul speaks of God saving all Israel, and 1st Cor. 5:6-8 where Paul exhorts Christians to keep Passover). At the time there was a large backlash against Sixtus from all the churches in Asia Minor (modern day Turkey) and Syria, etc., but that would be squelched by Constantine 200 years later. Christians can proclaim Catholicism's "illicit SEX and anti-Mosaic Law Jesus" to any people group in the world except to the Jews because they know that God Himself gave them Mosaic Law from Mt. Sinai, and as God says to them many times, it's to be kept throughout their generations (Ex. [12:14](#), 17; Lev. [23:14](#), 21, 31, etc.), not just until the Messiah comes (Luke 16:16 notwithstanding; see v. 17). Also, Jesus said that He did not come to do away with Mosaic Law. Does it get any plainer than that? The Lord said, "Do not think that I came to destroy the Law or the Prophets. I did not come to destroy but to fulfill." (Matthew 5:17 NKJV) The Church teaches that the Law was "fulfilled" at the Cross and so Christians don't have to be concerned about it, but listen to what Jesus said to His Apostles about "fulfill" after His Resurrection: "Then He said to them, "These are the words which I spoke to you while I was still with you, that all things must be fulfilled which were written in the Law of Moses and the Prophets and the Psalms concerning Me." And He opened their understanding that they might comprehend the Scriptures. Then He said to them, "Thus it is written and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day.""(Luke 24:44-46 NKJV; cf. v. 37; Acts 13:29, 32-33)

(I wrote some more and ended it by saying that he could contact me through my website.)

Then Octavius wrote back:

I'm not interested in contacting you and I have no interest in holding to the law, for I am under grace. You need to ask God for Holy Spirit because you're scattered and all over the place. You need the wisdom of God to reveal to you the revealed Jesus not the concealed Jesus I won't be responding to this conversation any longer. Peace and blessings.

And I wrote back saying,

I understand, but please do not present yourself as a prophet because you have not heard from Jesus on this matter.
