Shalom Avram,

Back in South Africa but I must confess, a part of my heart remained in Israel!

Avram, I am assured that my visit to your home was meant to be the highlite of my 10 day stay in Israel. When I look back I realise that it was nothing but an appointment devinely set up by our Father. I am so greatfull for the precious time that you and Ruti were prepared to spend with me. I think that I did share

with you how the Lord showed me His restoration of the true apostolic council of truth and righteousness in Israel even before I left South Africa. I therefore trusted from that moment that He would lead me to be able to be exposed to that while in Israel. It is so necessary for someone like me to continuously be able to open up my life and work in God's Kingdom to men like yourself.

I was truly blessed to have met you and Ruti. When I approached you, all I found was the true currency of His Kingdom, God's love and nothing else. Then, the more I was exposed to your lifestyle, the more I discovered that the fruit of your work is much more than mere words and the formulation of Biblical truths. *I discovered that every spoken word that comes from your mouth, flows from a life that you live.* This is a very scarce thing to find in the world today.

It is so clear to me that the Lord has placed you strategically in these exciting times to bear the kind of fruit that many could enjoy while in your presence and also thereafter. I feel that I need to say this, as we often come to times in our lives when we begin to doubt the importance of what we do. I say this to encourage you to endure in what you do. I found it to be more precious than gold. I immediately began reading the book that I received from you. I'm working slowly through each page, including all the footnotes. Each page is a feast of precious information. It is such a great tool to align our mindset in a way that we can be spiritually more open to the holy truth of the whole Bible. In between I also read some of the shorter printed articles. Also a great blessing in the true sense of the word. My friend in the printing business says that the articles would be ideal for printing in soft copy, PDF form. So far everybody that I could share my experience with have mentioned their desire to share in your teaching material.

Something more personal. After talking to you about the wearing of tzit'ziot, I went and read the scripture you gave me in Numbers 15:37-40. This happened while I was in Galilee. There the Lord spoke to me in a wonderful way...He assured me that the changes that He brought about in my life till now can be compared to the outer garment, the one visible to all those on the outside, but then He further assured me that the things that will change from now on will be more intimate things, things of deep within, the things not so visible from far away, like the wearing of an under garment, the one close to your skin and closest to one's heart. I immediately asked the question, 'Lord will this be symbolically correct?' He then answered my question with a question: 'Why do people wear wedding rings? Does the ring not say a lot of what happened to that person wearing the ring?' I immediately understood that the significance does not really lie in the ring itself, but in that which the ring stands for.

I then went into the Sea of Galilee in the same manner that men go through the mikveh for special occasions, and when I returned to Jerusalem I went to a store and bought tzit'ziot for me and my son. I also found the blue thread from the same store. Thank you for your guidance regarding the subject.

My last day (Thursday) was real hectic. I spent the morning buying a few gifts and the afternoon on Mount Olives, overlooking Tzion. At midnight the shuttle came to fetch me and dropped me at the airport at about 1 am. This left me with a comfortable 4 hours before boarding the plane. The flight home was pleasant and the following three days I just spent without any real program. During this time I came to realise how much our Lord had done in my life during the time in Israel. I cannot really describe it in words, but can discern that I am a new person. Praise be to our God the Father and Yeshua Messiah! I also know that there are many areas of our life and ministry that now need attention and change.

As we share this with others, they all witness that they are equally convinced to follow in the same manner. Praise God for that! Once again thank you for your love and willingness to listen and to guide. I thank the Lord daily for the precious bond that formed between us. I pray that this will grow into a tree that will provide shadow for many others to follow.
