5. [Books to Read](#) and Movies to see. A number of the books and movies can be read or seen online for free. All of these books are “must read” books, and all the movies are “must see” movies to further one’s understanding of Scripture, Yeshua, Jews, the world and us:
 1. Avram Yehoshua—[SAM the Rock Thrower](#) *and Other Times of Witnessing in Israel*. Avram (and his wife Ruti) lived in Israel for 16 years and he witnessed to literally thousands of Israelis “one on one,” on the streets, buses, restaurants and market places of Israel. In “Sam” you’ll see how Avram uses only the Old Testament to witness to his Jewish people about the Messiah of Israel. You’ll also learn how to witness to the Jewish people through osmosis (reading the book!). It’s captivating and informative; a priceless treasure and an important contribution to Jewish evangelism. Avram also interweaves his testimony throughout the book. I’ve made it available for free. Freely have I been given from Above, and freely I give. It’s all part of being in the Family. Brothers don’t charge their brothers and sisters for books they’ve written.
 2. Avram Yehoshua—[The Lifting of the Veil: Acts 15:20-21](#). Those two verses establish Mosaic Law as God’s lifestyle for every Christian by revealing that the four rules of James (v. 20) weren’t given for Table Fellowship, as the Church falsely teaches, but rather, the four rules are a conceptual unit on sacrificial-sexual idolatry. The early Gentile Christians had to sever themselves from their gross practice of sacrificial-sexual idolatry, which was the religion of most Gentiles, in order for their faith in Jesus to be genuine, for most Gentiles *would have just added* “Jesus” to their pantheon of pagan gods and goddesses, not realizing that Jesus doesn’t countenance any rivals. These four rules for the Gentiles weren’t the only rules, as the Church again heretically teaches, but the most important rules that the new Gentiles had to know, because worship of other gods along with Jesus, would negate their salvation, the very theme of the Council of Acts 15 (cf. Acts 15:1-5f.). From the time of Cornelius & Friends in Acts 10, nine years earlier, James realized that the Gentile Christians *had been learning Torah* (Mosaic Law) in the synagogues (Acts 15:21; cf. James 2:2, where the *Greek word for synagogue* is used, but most English Bibles have “assembly” or “congregation”), and this is why James acknowledges it in Acts 15:21, that the Gentiles were going, and would continue to go, to the synagogues or house churches to learn about the God of Israel and His Way of living out their faith in Yeshua through Torah. My latest version is also free, just click on the title above. (If you like to get an older hard copy, you can get the 2015 edition on Amazon, but the book on my website is a revised 2023 version). Read it for free.
5. Alfred Edersheim—[Sketches of Jewish Social Life](#) takes one into the ancient world of the Jewish people in the days of Yeshua and reveals their clothing and culture. You can read this informative book for free.
6. Alfred Edersheim—[The Life and Times of Jesus The Messiah](#). In the late 1800s, Edersheim was the chief authority on the understanding of Talmud (the oral “Bible” of the Pharisees), and Yeshua. Edersheim’s Christian classic reveals insights into many things of Yeshua’s time, one of which is how different the teachings of the Pharisees were to Messiah’s, even though many of them looked similar. You can also read this

- book for free.
7. Alfred Edersheim—[The Temple: It's Ministry and Services](#). Another great book by Edersheim in which he reveals the daily life of the Temple and its sacrifices, and the priests who made it possible. This is also a free book to read.
 8. Amy Carmichael—*Mimosa* (Fort Washington, PA: CLC Publications, 2015). Amy was an English woman who lived and ministered in the 19th and 20th centuries. She dedicated her life to Jesus, serving Him in India. Her life story is very inspirational, but in *Mimosa* she writes of a young Hindu girl, Mimosa, who heard Amy speak of Jesus only once. Mimosa was forbidden by her Hindu father to learn anymore of Jesus. In the few minutes that Mimosa heard Amy speak of Jesus, she grew up and became an incredible Christian of faith who trusted in Jesus in ways we can't begin to imagine, just from the short time that she heard Amy speak to Mimosa's older sister and her father about Him that one time. A truly amazing story of how the Lord Yeshua leads His lambs to Himself, and watches over them to protect them and to provide for them.
 9. Bodie and Brock Thoene—*The Zion Chronicles* (Bethany House Publishers, 1988). This is one of the most enthralling books I have ever read. As the Jewish people struggle to recover from the horrors of the Nazis, who savagely murdered two-thirds of European Jewry, Jews stream into British Palestine, and the nations wonder if the Jews will be slaughtered once again—this time by the Arabs in Palestine and seven other Arab nations. The Thoenes interweave historical fact with their characters to create a priceless glimpse of the Christian, Jewish and Arab drama that surrounded the establishment of the State of Israel in 1948. It's an exciting series that Ruti and I couldn't put down. You can get a used five paperback series for about \$25 on eBay.
 10. Bruce Olson—*Bruchko*. The true story of teenager Bruce Olson and his life of faith among the Montilone Indians in South America, and the truly incredible way the Lord led him to offer the Gift of eternal life to the Montilones and other primitive tribes.
 11. Carolyn Glick, *The Israeli Solution—A One-State Plan for Peace in the Middle East* (New York: Crown Forum; 2014). "Everyone" is set on a two state solution, but in all these years it hasn't come about, and hopefully, it won't. Glick has the intelligence and the insight to present a one-state solution. Excellent!
 12. Corrie ten Boom—*The Hiding Place* (New York: Bantam Books, 1974). Corrie's father taught his daughters that the Jews were God's chosen people, and so when the Nazis invaded Holland (the Netherlands) during WWII, the family hid many Jews and helped them to escape to farms, etc. One day they were caught by the Nazis and imprisoned. It was in prison that Corrie learned the divine lesson, from her sister Betsy, that you fight fire with the Water of Jesus' Love and Forgiveness, even and especially for her enemies.
 13. Corrie ten Boom—*Tramp for the Lord* (New York: Jove Books, 1978). After WWII Jesus led Corrie to travel around the world and share how she was able to forgive the very Nazi prison guard who ruthlessly and unmercifully persecuted her sister Betsy unto death, and many others, while in a Nazi prison death camp during WWII.
 14. Dave Hunt—*A Woman Rides the Beast* (Eugene, OR: Harvest House Publishers, 1994). Alexander Hislop wrote of the Roman Catholic Church being the Harlot of New Testament Babylon, and revealed how Catholicism is a perfect copy of ancient Babylon's religion. Dave Hunt, in his complementary book, fills in the gaps of Rome's demonic cruelty, persecution and murder of millions of Protestant Christians over the centuries, who would not bow their knees to the ruthless Popes and their doctrines of sprinkling infants and transubstantiation—the bread actually becoming the body of Jesus; the wine, His blood, and the priest re-sacrificing Christ in the Eucharist (communion). One of the startling things about Hunt's book is that he reveals that what Rome did to Protestants in the past, is actually happening today in countries in South America. In other words, whenever Rome has political power it uses it to crush any Christian opposition to Herself.
 15. Dave Roberson—[The Walk of the Spirit](#). Roberson shares how he came to be gloriously baptized in the

- Holy Spirit, and how we can be too. Many excellent insights into how to walk in the Holy Spirit. It's a free download.
16. David Bivin and Roy Blizzard—*Understanding the Difficult Words of Jesus* (Shippensburg, Pennsylvania: Destiny Image Publishers, 2001). The two authors, having translated the Greek New Testament into modern Hebrew, found that a number of the Greek passages, which made no sense in Greek, became understandable in Hebrew. Many passages come alive as their true Hebrew meanings are seen. Excellent book!
 17. David Wilkerson—*The Cross and the Switchblade* (Grand Rapids, MI: Zondervan, 1963-2000). Wilkerson was catapulted into national fame when the Lord led him from his small Assembly of God congregation in Pennsylvania, to proclaim Jesus to gang members in New York City. The leading and power of the Holy Spirit to deliver drug addicts is clearly seen in this telling of how it all began and also, how Teen Challenge grew out of this.
 18. Derek and Lydia Prince—*Appointment in Jerusalem* (New Kensington, PA: Whitaker House, 1975-2005). Lydia was a Christian in Europe whom God filled with the Holy Spirit, and then mightily used in Israel to save both Jewish and Arab children whom no one wanted. A powerful story.
 19. Dr. Howard Taylor—*The Spiritual Secret of Hudson Taylor* (New Kensington, PA: Whitaker House, 1996). Hudson Taylor was born in England in 1832. He would “single-handedly” open up mainland China for Jesus Christ. His spiritual secret is a divine gift to the Body of Messiah in how to always know that one is walking with the Lord.
 20. Elisabeth Elliot—*A Chance to Die: The Story of Amy Carmichael* (Grand Rapids, MI: Revell, 1987). Amy (Dec. 16, 1867–Jan. 18, 1951) grew up in England and gave her life to Jesus, who led her to India to serve Him by taking care of orphans. She opened an orphanage and founded a mission and served in India for 55 years. Amy wrote many books about the missionary work there and is seen as a godly woman who gave herself totally to Jesus.
 21. Elmer Josephson—*God's Key to Health and Happiness* (Grand Rapids, MI: Fleming H. Revell, 1985). Josephson was a pastor in Kansas who had been told by the doctors to go home and die, for they could do nothing more for him. The Lord led him to stop eating pig and he began to follow the Mosaic Dietary laws and he fully recovered and lived for many years. He writes about it and *God's Key to health and Happiness*.
 22. F. F. Bosworth—[Christ the Healer](#). Bosworth was used mightily by the Lord in healing many thousands of people. His prayer was that Christians would learn to apply the promises of God's Word to their lives through his book. Bosworth offers an excellent discussion of healing, based on the premise that Jesus redeemed us from all our diseases (Is. 53:5) when he atoned for our sins. You can download the book for free.
 23. Frank Bartleman—*Azusa Street* (New Kensington, Penn: Whitaker House, 1982). First published in 1925, this book is an important account of an event which has, over the past century, swept the world and transformed Christianity as nothing else has since the days of the Apostles. The Holy Spirit was poured out on Azusa Street in Los Angeles from 1906-1909 in a way that the world had not seen before nor since.
 24. Gene Edwards—*A Tale of Three Kings* (Wheaton, IL: Tyndale House Publishing, Inc., 1992). Incredibly insightful into our human nature and how to follow God or to rebel against Him. Edwards uses three Old Testament characters, King Saul, King David, and King Absalom, to reveal how to steer clear of the first and the last one, and how to follow Yeshua as David did.
 25. Gordon Tessler—*The Genesis Diet* (Raleigh, North Carolina: Be Well Publications, 1996). The Genesis Diet offers many fine insights into the biblical foundation for eating.
 26. Hannah Hurnard—*Hinds' Feet on High Places* (Uhrichville, OH: Barbour Books; Tyndale House Publishers, 1977; the complete and unabridged edition). In the early 1900s, Yeshua took an anti-Semitic English girl and made her a missionary to the Jewish and Arab people of Palestine. Her book follows the adventures, trials, set backs and ultimate success of the main character that she names, Little Much Afraid, as she tries to

- follow the Shepherd to the place of transformation and Life.
27. Harry Zvi Hurwitz—*Begin: His Life, Words and Deeds* (Jerusalem: Gefen Publishing House, 2004). Menachem Begin’s most important and unique contribution to the Jewish people was his selfless, sacrificial serving of the people of Israel, his wisdom in leading them, and also defending Israel. One such example was the bombing of the Iraqi nuclear plant on June 7th, 1981. Menachem Begin loved the people of Israel and the Land of Israel. His character came out in his deep faith and courage, as well as his modesty, integrity, truthfulness and adherence to the principles of “right,” no matter how difficult or unpopular it was. Begin was the most beloved Prime Minister Israel has ever had because he was ‘one’ with his Jewish people and they knew it. A great book, told by Harry Hurwitz, the man who was Begin’s secretary for many years.
 28. Howard M. Sachar—*A History of Israel From the Rise of Zionism to Our Time* (New York: Alfred A. Knopf, 2000). A foundational “must book” to understand the history of Israel. Excellent!
 29. Jack Deere—*Surprised by the Power of the Spirit* (Grand Rapids, MI: Zondervan, 1993). A former Dallas Seminary professor who taught that the Gifts of the Spirit had long ago ceased, describes his personal journey away from that false dispensational view into the fuller, biblical experience of the Holy Spirit.
 30. Janet and Geoff Benge—*Charles Mulli* (Seattle, WA: YWAM Publications, 2017). When Charles Mulli was a child, his family repeatedly abandoned him, and he lived in fear of his abusive, alcoholic father. With an extraordinary will, the young Kenyan struggled to feed and educate himself. He became a multimillionaire and father of eight, and encountering hope and life in the Gospel, found a reason to live and to forgive. The entrepreneur sold his businesses to devote himself to caring for street children (orphans) throughout Kenya. Since 1989, Charles and his wife Esther, have taken into their protection thousands of the most vulnerable children through Mulli Children’s Family, revealing in the midst of brokenness, God’s astonishing redemptive power. After Mulli had spent all his fortune on the children, he found that Jesus always provides. A riveting book reflecting Mulli’s life.
 31. John Bunyan, Author; L. Edward Hazelbaker, Translator—[*The Pilgrim’s Progress*](#) (North Brunswick, NJ: Bridge-Logos Publishers, 1998). The Pilgrims Progress is a famous story of man’s journey through life in search of salvation and remains one of the most entertaining allegories of faith ever written. John Bunyan (1628-1688) was an English writer and Baptist preacher best known for his Christian allegory *The Pilgrim’s Progress*. Bunyan spent many years in prison for his faith in Jesus, and it was during this time that he began writing *The Pilgrim’s Progress*. It’s the second best selling book for the last 200 years; second only to the Bible. Hazelbaker does a tremendous job in retaining the essence of the work while updating it for modern English readers. (Get a used book as Amazon wants \$25.65 for a new one; an outrageous price. You’ll see “used books” from \$13.38 when you click on the URL or you can get it on Kindle for \$8.24.)
 32. Kay Arthur—*Israel My Beloved* (Eugene, OR: Harvest house Publishers, 1996). The book begins with the tragic and horrible sins that led to Israel’s captivity by and in Babylon, and extends all the way to the modern-day miracles of triumph for Israel, against all odds. It’s an incredible testimony of God’s great love and faithfulness to Israel, even and especially after her sins of idolatry.
 33. Larry Martin, Dr.—*The Life and Ministry of William J. Seymour* (Pensacola, FL: Christian Life Books), 2006. Beginning in 1906, Seymour led a revival that spread the Baptism of the Holy Spirit around the world. In 1999 religious newswriters voted the Azusa Street Revival as one of the ten most important religious events of the *millennium*. Seymour has been called the most influential black religious leader in American history. Born in 1870 in Centerville, Louisiana, William Seymour left the south and lived in Missouri, Indiana, Illinois and Ohio, usually working as a hotel waiter. He was baptized as a Roman Catholic, converted in a Methodist Church, and then joined the Church of God Reformation movement. In 1905 he encountered Charles Parham in Houston, Texas and embraced the Pentecostal teaching of the Baptism in the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in tongues. In April 1906 God poured out His Spirit upon Seymour and for three years he held services three times a day, seven days a week, and sent out many missionaries around the

- world with the message of Pentecost.
34. Larry Martin, Dr.—*The True Believers* (Pensacola, FL: Christian Life Books), 1998. The book is a collection of testimonies from eye witnesses that attended the services at Azusa Street under Seymour. Awesome!
 35. Michael Oren—*Ally* (New York: Random House, 2015). Oren does an excellent job of cataloguing Obama’s disastrous policies, from his Cairo speech to the concessions he made to Iran. A gifted historian whose account of America’s interventions in the Middle East, “Power, Faith and Fantasy,” was a best seller, Oren grew up an American in West Orange, New Jersey, and emigrated to Israel in 1979. Three decades later he became Israeli ambassador to the USA. Well written!
 36. Norman Grubb—*Rees Howells: Intercessor* (Fort Washington, PA: CLC Publications, 2016). A most godly man whom the Lord used in many ways, one of which was the saving of England in WWII through prayer.
 37. Roberts Liardon—*John G. Lake—The Complete Collection of His Life Teachings* (Tulsa, OK: Albury Publishing, 1999). Lake (1870-1935) was used by our Lord to lead thousands into the Baptism of the Holy Spirit, and heal many tens of thousands. An incredibly inspirational book, it also speaks of his accounts with healing people, etc.
 38. Samuele Bacchiocchi—[From Sabbath To Sunday](#). This is the definitive work on the issue of God’s Sabbath vs. Rome’s Sunday. Bacchiocchi reveals that it was Rome, about 120 AD, through Pope Sixtus, who threw out Mosaic Law and brought in *illicit SEX* (an acronym for Sunday, Easter and Xmas, which also includes the eating of pig and other unclean animals; anti-Mosaic Law and anti-Semitism). It was not Constantine 200 years later, who elevated the Roman Church to official status within his empire, therefore “authorizing” Rome’s heresies. Bacchiocchi explains the glory that is God’s Sabbath and deals with Scripture that the Church uses to invalidate the Sabbath, as well as presenting the historical understanding as to what was happening in the second century, revealing that Man, not God, changed Sabbath to Sunday. It’s a free read.
 39. Tom Segev, Author; Haim Watzman, translator—*The Seventh Million: The Israelis and the Holocaust* (New York: Henry Holt and Company, 2000). Segev shows the “decisive impact of the Holocaust on the identity, ideology and politics of Israel” (back cover). Well worth the read.
 40. Tommy Welchel—*Azusa Street: They Told Me Their Stories* (USA: Dare 2 Dream Books, 2010). The book gives you an account of over three years of eye witness reports of *daily* healing miracles. Some were spectacular, like the growing back of missing fingers or limbs. Old rotten teeth were replaced by new teeth. No one was turned away without a healing. All of the miracles were performed by invoking the power of the Holy Spirit in the name of the Jesus.
 41. Yehuda Avner—*The Prime Ministers* (Jerusalem: The Toby Press, 2010). The book reveals Israeli politics from an insider’s perspective, from the founding of the Jewish State to 2009. We are privy to stunning details of life-and-death decision-making, top-secret military operations and high level peace negotiations. An excellent book!
 42. **MOVIES**
 1. [Above and Beyond](#) is an incredible documentary about how God, in 1948, used a few WWII American Jewish volunteer pilots to help fight for Israel’s independence and survival, and literally saved the Jewish people there from annihilation. At the time Israel had no air force nor any military planes; just a couple of piper cubs, which is seen in the film, [To Cast a Giant Shadow](#). The day after Israel announced its statehood, Israel was attacked by seven Arab nations (Egypt, Syria, Jordan, Saudi Arabia, Lebanon, Yemen and Iraq). They spoke of overrunning Israel and murdering all the Jews, saying that what Hitler had done would be nothing compared to what they would do to the Jews. Their military might was staggering compared to the Jews who didn’t have any tanks or military planes, and also, most of the Jewish “Army” consisted of Holocaust survivors who had literally “just got off the boat,” untrained in warfare, and who were vastly outnumbered by professional Arab soldiers, but the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob was on the side of Israel. It’s \$3.99 on Amazon Prim or maybe free on YouTube, but does have

some language that is inappropriate for young children.

2. [An American Tail](#) is about a family of Jewish Russian *mice* who leave Czarist Russia, due to the pogroms of the Cossack cats, and emigrate by boat to America. On the way, young Fievel is lost overboard, washes ashore in the USA, and experiences thrilling adventures as he tries to find his parents in this animated family classic. It's \$3.99 on Amazon Prime and great for children of all ages.
3. [Avalon](#)—A Jewish family comes to the USA at the beginning of the 20th century, and they and their children try to make themselves a better future in the world's version of "the promised land." An exceptional movie! \$3.99 on Amazon Prime.
4. [Behind the Sun](#) is the story of a young Arab man, born and raised a Muslim in the Middle East, who, while attending college in America, finds Jesus. After receiving a degree and a good job, he goes back home on vacation to see his parents, and wants to eventually tell them about Jesus, but the Lord has, what at first, turns out to be the scariest adventure of his life. The man faces the wrath of his father and relatives for converting to the religion "of a dead man!" It's a great movie on "faith under Fire." It's free on Amazon Prime or YouTube.
5. [Ben Hur](#) with Charlton Heston is an epic drama about an aristocratic Jew living in Judah during the time of Yeshua, who incurs the wrath of a Roman tribune, who was once his best friend. Although forced into slavery on a galley by the tribune, and compelled to witness the cruel persecution of his mother and sister, he survives, harboring dreams of vengeance, until he meets Jesus. \$3.99 on Amazon Prime.
6. [Defiance](#) with Daniel Craig. In 1941, Nazi soldiers and the SS are slaughtering Eastern European Jews by the hundreds of thousands. Three brothers, Tuvia (Daniel Craig), Zus (Liev Schreiber) and Asa'el (Jamie Bell), manage to escape and take refuge in the forest where they played in childhood. Seeking a way to avenge the death of their parents, the brothers turn their daily struggle for survival into a battle against the Nazis who come after them. As news of their exploits spread, other Jewish men, women and children, join the brothers, and a community of 1,000 Jewish people forms. They live for years in the Belarussian Forest between Belarus and Poland, encountering Nazi attacks, but setting up a school and community that can move out at a moment's notice. It's an excellent movie. \$3.99 on Amazon Prime.
7. [Denial](#)—Deborah E. Lipstadt (Rachel Weisz), an American woman, battles for historical truth in Britain, when infamous Holocaust denier, David Irving (Timothy Spall), sues her for libel (1996) concerning what Deborah wrote in her book, *Denying the Holocaust* (1993), about Irving. It's not "an open and shut case," as British law is not on her side. A very gripping movie. Free on Amazon Prime, and possibly YouTube also.
8. [Exodus](#) with Paul Newman. The movie is based on Leon Uris' novel of the same name and is an historical epic movie that provides a dramatic backdrop to the creation of the State of Israel in 1948, in the aftermath of the Holocaust and World War II. Ari Ben Canaan (Paul Newman), a passionate member of the Jewish paramilitary group Haganah, attempts to transport 600 Jewish refugees on a dangerous voyage in the Mediterranean Sea, from Cyprus to Palestine, on a rickety ship renamed, Exodus, for obvious, biblically symbolic reasons. He faces obstruction from the anti-Semitic British government, army and navy of that time, who will not grant the ship passage out of the harbor to its destination. The ship becomes a symbol for the rebirth of the nation of Israel out of the ashes of the Holocaust. Many facets of Jewish resistance against the heartless British government, who had interned (read: imprisoned) the Jewish people on Crete, who wanted to live in Palestine, are presented in the movie. It's a very powerful film, with Ari falling in love with an American Gentile woman, who is not concerned about the Jews, until she falls in love with a teenage Jewish girl who survived the Nazi camps of extermination, and of course, she then falls in love with Ari (Paul Newman) and becomes emotionally understanding and concerned about the plight of the Jews and their hope for survival in the land of their Fathers. \$3.99 on Amazon Prime, but it may be free on YouTube.

9. [Fiddler on the Roof](#) with Topol and Norma Crane. This is the quintessential story of the Jewish people in anti-Semitic Europe, symbolized with Tevye, the Jewish milkman, his family and his Jewish community in anti-Semitic Czarist Russia in the early 1900s. An incredible movie. It's \$3.99 on Amazon Prime, but may be free (with ads) on YouTube.
10. [Follow Me](#) is the story of Yoni (Yonatan) Netanyahu, the older brother of the Prime Minister of Israel, Benjamin Netanyahu. Yoni was a lieutenant colonel when he masterminded and led the Israeli raid on Entebbe, where more than 80 Israelis and non-Israeli Jews were being held captive by terrorists. They had hijacked an Air France plane going from Athens to Paris, and commandeered it to Entebbe, Uganda. The Israeli raid on Entebbe became the world's model for dealing with terrorists and their demands to let their "terrorist brothers" go free from prisons around the world. It's free on Amazon Prime or YouTube.
11. [I Believe](#)—The beautiful story of a nine year old boy, Brian, who sees a church sign speaking of Jesus saying "Greater things you will do..." and whose pure and innocent faith brings about manifestations of God's extraordinary power that quickly become breaking news. He faces heavy opposition from the world around him, especially from his own father Simon, an atheist TV Newscaster. It's a heart-warming and inspirational film. It's free on the above link to YouTube, but \$4 on Amazon.
12. [Jesus of Nazareth](#). Absolutely the best "Jesus" movie ever made. Starring Olivia Hussey as Mary, this epic film includes Ernest Borgnine, James Farentino, James Earl Jones, Stacy Keach, James Mason, Laurence Olivier, Christopher Plummer, Anthony Quinn, Rod Steiger, Peter Ustinov (who does an incredible job as King Herod), and Michael York as John the Baptist (a super performance). Robert Powell portrays Jesus, the most believable "Jesus" on film. It's on YouTube with ads, or you can pay \$1.99 (Amazon) to see it without the ads, which is a much better choice. 13. [La Rafle](#)—Jean Reno and Melanie Laurent star in Rose Bosch's, La Rafle (The Roundup). It presents the true story, through the eyes of a French Gentile nurse, who risked her own life, as the Nazis rounded up French Jews to be sent to the death camps in Poland. Very touching. Free on Amazon Prime.
14. [Labyrinth of Lies](#)—Upon learning that many former Nazis returned to their pre-war lives with no penalty or punishment, an integrous German prosecutor vows to bring them to justice. This movie reveals how one man of integrity can make an incredible difference. Excellent movie.
15. [Palau—The Movie](#)—The story of Luis Palau (1934-2021), an Argentinian man who lost his father at ten years old, and whom God would use to evangelize the world. He proclaimed the Message of Jesus to 25 million people in more than 75 nations, before he died in March 2021.
16. [Run Boy Run!](#)—A gripping film based on true events, about a Jewish boy continually escaping the clutches of the Nazis. Free on Amazon Prime.
17. [Stars in the Galaxy—Indescribable](#) by Louie Giglio. An excellent presentation of the God who designed the universe and our relation to the stars and Him.
18. [The Chosen](#) starring Rod Steiger as a Hasidic rabbi and his desire to direct his son (Robby Benson) in the right path of Hasidism. Maximillian Schnell plays an Orthodox rabbi whose own son befriends the Hasidic rabbi's son, and that's when the two totally different Jewish worlds clash. An excellent film. 19. [The Courageous Heart of Irena Sendler](#) is the inspiring World War II drama about Irena Sendler, a Polish woman who saved 2,500 Jewish children in the Warsaw Ghetto. Based on a true story, the movie shows Irena's efforts to develop a network of contacts to accomplish her dangerous mission. Using fake identification to pass herself off as a nurse, Irena, who was a social worker, until the Nazis stopped all

social workers from going into the Ghetto, is able to continue to enter the Ghetto as a nurse. This allows her to save Jewish children by “smuggling” them out of the Ghetto and placing them with trustworthy Catholic families, who teach them to pass as Polish Catholic children so the German authorities never know the difference, yet who are told of the being Jews after the war. 20. [The Devil’s Arithmetic](#) with Kirsten Dunst and Brittany Murphy. An exceptional film about the profound change of attitude a Jewish American teenage girl, in the 1980s, has about Passover and the Holocaust once she is transported back in time to a Polish Jewish village that is about to be taken to a Nazi concentration camp. It’s free on Amazon Prime or YouTube.
21. [The Jewish Cardinal](#)—The true and riveting story of a Catholic Cardinal, of Jewish heritage, whose connection to his Jewish father grows as he protests the construction of a convent on the grounds of Auschwitz. Free on Amazon Prime, with ads, and probably YouTube also.
22. [The Last Princess](#)—Princess Deok-Hye was the last princess of Korea. Under Japanese colonial rule, she was taken to Japan at the age of 13, as a hostage, years before WWII. She struggles to maintain the hope of the Korean people, but she is thwarted on every side. Jang-Han is a fighter for Korean independence. His mission is to bring Princess Deok-Hye home to Korea, but it takes him decades after WWII (1962) to finally bring her home. It is an extremely poignant film about what the Princess and many Koreans endured, depicting the cruelty of not only the Japanese, but especially the Koreans who worked for the Japanese against their own country. We Jews know the savagery of Adolf Hitler and Joseph Stalin, and many, many others, but Japan was vicious against her enemies, especially Korea and China. World history is full of dictators and kings who murdered their own people for not bowing down to them, and this picture encapsulates that. Please pray for the people of Korea and China...and Japan.
23. [The Little Traitor](#)—This is a fictional and insightful story of an unlikely friendship between a British sergeant and an Israeli boy, and the problems they faced from their respective group. It’s set against the backdrop of the birth of the State of Israel in 1948. Free on Amazon Prime.
24. [The Pilgrim’s Progress](#)—While in prison for his faith, John Bunyan wrote a book that, since the 17th century, has sold more books than any other book in the world, except the Bible. This is an excellent animated version of the book, which is free on Amazon Prime, and with adds on [YouTube](#).
25. [The Rabbi From Tarsus](#) is played by Phil Goble. An incredible performance of the last day in the life of the Apostle Paul in the dungeon of Nero. 2. Six YouTube messages on The Hebraic Perspective

#1: [Introduction](#)—The Abrahamic Call to the Wilderness; The Hebraic Perspective vs. Messianic Judaism and Hebrew Roots; and The Two Distinct Streams of Pauline theology on Mosaic Law. It's 62 minutes. The filming began about 15 minutes after I started speaking and so it picks up at that point instead of at the beginning.

#2: [Pillar One](#)—The Feasts of Israel as Time Markers in the Book of Acts describe when an event took place. How could Luke, a Gentile Christian, use six of the Feasts as Time Markers for Gentile Theophilus if the Law of Moses wasn't valid for Christians? Theo wouldn't have know when an event happened. The Church teaches that Mosaic Law/the Feasts of Israel were done away with at the Cross, but the Book of Acts declares loud and clear that Mosaic Law was valid for Gentiles Christians many years *after* the Resurrection. Luke wrote Acts in 64 AD, 34 years *after* the Resurrection. The teaching is 69 minutes.

#3: [Pillar Two](#)—The 7th day Sabbath is a *perfect* picture of Messiah Yeshua and why it was the only thing in Creation that was both blessed and made holy (Gen. 2:1-3). Not even Man, created on Day Six, was called blessed or holy. In Acts 15:20 James speaks of the new Gentile Christians going to the synagogue *on the Sabbath day*. Acts 15 took place 18 years *after* the Resurrection. Also,

Pillar Three—Animal Sacrifice by the Apostles 25 Years *after* the Resurrection. If there's anything the Church is vehement about it's that animal sacrifice ended at the Cross, but in Acts 21:20-26 the Apostle Paul himself enters into the Nazarite Vow, with its animal sacrifices (Num. 6:14). The video is 75 minutes long.

#4: [Pillar Four](#)—The Mosaic Dietary Laws. The Church uses three proof texts to justify the eating of pork, ham, bacon, shrimp and catfish, etc., but Avram reveals how wrong the Church's interpretation of those texts are in, Paul & the Pig; Peter & the Pig; and Jesus & the Pig (1st Tim. 4:4-5; Acts 10:1f.; Matt 15:1-20; Mk. 7:1f., respectively). It's 87 minutes.

#5: In this video Avram teaches that the Law of Moses is God's Righteous Standard for judging sin, knowing God's will and walking out our faith in Messiah Yeshua. Also, as Yeshua reveals, Mosaic Law is God's very definition of how to love Him and each other. 78 minutes.

#6: [Has the Church replaced Israel?](#) Not according to God's Word in the New Testament. The Greek word for church (*ekklaysia*)

was *first used of Israel in the Wilderness at Mt. Sinai*. When Paul used it he wasn't the first, nor was he making a distinction between "the Church" and the Jewish people, but rather that *what God had begun at Mt. Sinai, the Kingdom of God on Earth, was now continuing in Messiah Yeshua*.

Also helping us to understand how the Church wasn't meant to be a separate entity from the Jewish people is the fact that all Church positions (e.g. elder, pastor and evangelist, etc.) come from the Synagogue.

Lastly, and of great importance, is how the Four Rules of James (Acts 15:20) weren't given for Table Fellowship, as the Church erroneously teaches, but were a filter to determine if Gentile belief in Yeshua was genuine. This then becomes the theological CornerStone in the New Testament for walking out one's faith in Yeshua through the rules of Mosaic Law that apply to any one Christian. It's 98 minutes long.

They were sent out from 1988 to 2009 (over a 32 years period). Many Gentile Christian have been blessed by the insights they read, and some Jewish people actually came to give their lives to Yeshua through them. Praise Yeshua!
